REVIVAL OF HOPE

A note from Pastor Rob Ison

A New Beginning through Baptism

As they traveled along the road, they came to some water and the eunuch said, "Look, here is water. Why shouldn't I be baptized?" And he gave orders to stop the chariot. Then both Philip and the eunuch went down into the water and Philip baptized him.

Acts 8:35, 36, and 38 NIV

The NIV translation of this text leaves out verse 37 because it was not included in the oldest of manuscripts. The King James Version and other translations reveal that Philip answered the eunuch's questions by explaining, "If thou believest with all thine heart, thou mayest." When the eunuch heard this qualification for baptism, he answered by saying, "I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God."

We gain salvation as God's grace is applied to our lives when we have faith in Jesus Christ, God's only Son. After we have come to believe in Him, then we may proceed to be baptized by immersion. Baptism by full immersion in water provides a personal testimony that just as Jesus was dead, buried, and raised from the dead, we are dead to an old way and raised in baptism to a new life. This new life is made possible through the work of Jesus Christ and the Spirit of God that comes to indwell those who believe in God's Son. Baptism is not the act that makes us born again. It is merely the evidence of our intention to live for the LORD.

For many Christians of all ages, baptism reveals our hope in a new way. Many of us need to literally, start over. We need to make new commitments from time to time in our heart and in some cases, these new beginnings can be best expressed by being baptized. A Revival of Hope is available to those who desire a good conscience in their relationship with the LORD. When we know that we have done all He has commanded us to do, the joy and peace His Spirit gives is indescribable.
